Asunto: 15 y 16 septiembre: Seminario online gratuito de la EMSA sobre el Convenio HNS y webinar sobre el servicio MAR-ICE

Muy Srs. nuestros:

La Agencia Europea de Seguridad Marítima (EMSA) ha organizado para los días **15 y 16 de septiembre** un **seminario online gratuito** sobre la preparación y respuesta a incidentes marítimos relacionados con **sustancias químicas** o cargamentos de sustancias **peligrosas y nocivas** (*Hazardous and Noxious Substances*, HNS), cuyo programa y carta de invitación les adjuntamos en un **Anexo**.

El seminario está estructurado en 3 módulos independientes:

- **Módulos 1 y 2** (se impartirán el 15 de septiembre, en horario de 09:00 a 15:00 horas): reunirá a los actores clave más relevantes en la gestión de los incidentes HNS, quienes presentarán diferentes perspectivas a la vista de sus funciones, intereses y contribución en la cadena de respuesta al vertido de HNS, incluido el punto de vista del armador sobre un incidente real, y se analizarán estadísticas de incidentes recientes y las lecciones aprendidas.
- **Módulo 3** (se impartirá el 16 de septiembre, en horario de 09:00 a 11:30 horas): incluirá un seminario sobre el Servicio de Intervención Marina en Emergencias Químicas (MAR-ICE). Dicho servicio consiste en una red de expertos establecida por la EMSA en cooperación con el Consejo de la Industria Química Europea (Cefic) y el Centro de Documentación, Investigación y Experimentación sobre Contaminación Accidental del Agua (Cedre), que proporcionan previa solicitud y de forma gratuita un servicio de información a distancia específica (24 horas al día y 7 días a la semana) y asesoramiento sobre las sustancias químicas implicadas en los derrames marinos.

Las personas interesadas pueden participar en uno o en varios módulos. Para ello, deben **registrarse antes del 1 de septiembre** a través del enlace: <https://extranet.emsa.europa.eu/e-register/>, siguiendo las instrucciones que les indicamos a continuación:

- Abrir el enlace indicado, pulsar en la pestaña “Login” y rellenar los siguientes campos:

- En la pantalla que aparece, pulsar en la pestaña “Events”. Se muestra el menú titulado “Trainings and Workshops”. Subject: EMSA on-line workshop on chemical spill response and webinar on the MAR-ICE service (15-16 September 2021)

The preparedness for and response to maritime incidents involving chemicals or cargoes of hazardous and noxious (HNS) substances, poses an important challenge due to the complexity of the identification and assessment of the cargo associated risks and hazards and the response options to such incidents.

In addressing this priority concern in the EU, the European Maritime Safety Agency (EMSA) would like to invite you to an **online workshop on chemical spill response** to be held on **15 and 16 September 2021**, as per the preliminary programme attached in **Annex 1**.

The workshop aims to bring together relevant stakeholders from industry and governmental bodies to address different perspectives, look at recent incident statistics, lessons learnt and key challenges and to present existing services in this field.

Aiming to raise awareness, this on-line workshop has a wider target participant group, including national or local experts from relevant Member States administrations, regional and international organisations and industry dealing with or with an interest in chemical marine pollution preparedness and response issues.

Workshop Programme

This expert-level workshop consists of three stand-alone modules and will be held via videoconference on 15 September (from 09:00 hrs to 11:30 hrs and from 12:30 hrs to 15:00 hrs Lisbon time) and on 16 September (from 09:00 hrs to 11:30 hrs Lisbon time).

The workshop will have contributions from and will be open to participation from Member States relevant administrations, Regional Agreement Secretariats, IMO Secretariat and relevant industry associations and other organisations.

- **Day 1** (modules 1 and 2) will bring together relevant key players in HNS incident management, to present different perspectives in view of their roles, interests and contribution in the chain of HNS spill response, while also looking into recent incident statistics and lessons learnt.

- **Day 2** (module 3) will comprise of a webinar on the MAR-ICE service, a joint event among the three MAR-ICE partners (Cefic, Cedre and EMSA), hosted on-line by Cefic, aiming to raise awareness on the service for Member States authorities (service users) and the chemical industry (service providers).

You are invited to disseminate this information within your organisation or association, noting that several experts can attend per organisation and participants can register to attend all or only those workshop modules they are interested in; they will be able to indicate this when registering.

The final workshop programme and detailed information on the online platform to be used, as well as the required links to participate in the videoconference will be sent to registered participants in early September.
