Asunto: Suministro de electricidad en puerto: seminario y consulta de EMSA a las partes interesadas

El próximo **26 de marzo**, viernes, en horario de **10:00 a 14:00 horas**, la Agencia de Seguridad Marítima Europea (EMSA) tiene previsto celebrar por **videoconferencia** un seminario en inglés en el que va a presentar la estructura y proceso de desarrollo de unas **Directrices sobre el suministro de electricidad desde tierra** (*Onshore Power Supply, OPS*), la carga de baterías y otros aspectos de electrificación relevantes para los buques atracados en puerto. Este trabajo que está llevando a cabo EMSA abarca aspectos multidimensional de la electricidad en tierra, incluida la tecnología, el marco regulatorio, la planificación y viabilidad técnica, la operación, seguridad, certificación y cualificaciones. The European Maritime Safety Agency (EMSA) has been established under Regulation (EC) 1406/2002 (as amended) of the European Parliament and of the Council in order to ensure a high, uniform and effective level of maritime safety, maritime security, prevention of and response to pollution caused by ships, as well as response to marine pollution caused by oil and gas installations.

One of the main tasks of EMSA is the provision of technical, operational and scientific assistance to the Member States and the Commission. In this regard, EMSA is supporting the Commission in the implementation of the “European Green Deal”.

To this end EMSA is working on **Guidance on Shore Power Electricity**, including Onshore Power Supply (OPS), Battery Charging and other Electrification aspects relevant to Ships at Berth. The Work covers multi-dimensional aspects of the Shore-Side Electricity, including Technology, Regulatory Framework, Planning and Technical Feasibility, Operation, Safety, Certification and Qualifications.
